**A Medical Provider Authorization form** must be on file if your child needs medication in school. This form is also needed for cough drops. Medication is kept in a locked cabinet with the forms.

Please dress your child warmly for outside recess. Please **put your child's name in their boots and outer clothing** so they can be easily identified. Keep those kids bundled up and dry as we move closer to the winter months!
